## Register

- Register through [Greenlight Locker](#) using the [Student Quick Start Guide](#) on the first day of class.\*
  - You will need to include your full name, student ID#, phone number, and email.
  - Make sure to enter information that matches your high school student record.
  - Do not register directly on EdReady.

## Goals & Diagnostic

- Once registered, login to EdReady and choose Goals.
- Complete the Diagnostic.

## Stage 1

- Stage 1:** work through your goals to achieve **90% success**.
  - Use the study resources.
  - If you are studying English, you will need to complete the essay upon completion of Stage 1. Your instructor will share details about the essay assignment.

## Stage 2

- Stage 2:** After completion of Stage 1, move on to Stage 2 and work toward **90% success** for completion.

## Certificate

- When you have completed Stage 2, submit your *Certification of Completion* to colleges through the GreenLight Locker.
  - Colleges listed on [www.texascollegebridge.org](http://www.texascollegebridge.org) under the Higher Ed tab have agreed to review your completion and offer a TSI exemption.
