## Platform Format

- Format your class according to your district's determined platform.

## Communicate

- Communicate with students.
  - Explain the purpose of Texas College Bridge.
  - Ensure students are aware of which colleges accept the TSI Exemption for Texas College Bridge completion.
  - Provide the Greenlight Locker Registration [Quick Start Guide](#) and [Detailed Guide](#).

## Register

- Register through Greenlight Locker on the first day of class. Use the Registration [Quick Start Guide](#) and [Detailed Guide](#).
  - Do not register directly on EdReady: all user registrations must be through GreenLight Locker.

## Support

- Support your students' use of Texas College Bridge:
  - Help students get registered.
  - Encourage students to complete the diagnostic evaluation.
  - Make sure students understand how to successfully complete their study paths.
  - English only: Review, grade and provide feedback on written assignments.

## Guide Students

- Guide your students:
  - Check the Reporting Dashboard daily.
  - Contact students regularly to provide encouragement and intervention.
  - Understand and communicate student requirements: students need to complete both Stage 1 and 2 to earn their certification. For English, they will also have to pass the essay.

## Certificate
